Request for Proposals $\frac{3}{4}$ " & 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Base Aggregate Gravel Mintal Pit, Squaw Creek Road

Sealed proposals will be accepted by the Price County Highway Department, Phillips, WI until 12:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 27, 2023 at the office of the Price County Highway Commissioner, 704 N Lake Ave., P.O. Box 169, Phillips, WI 54555 for crushing and stockpiling 10,000 tons of $\frac{3}{4}$ " crushed base aggregate dense gravel, 15,000 tons of 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " crushed base aggregate dense gravel and 600 tons of crushed blacktop to be produced in the Price County owned, Mintal Pit, Squaw Creek Road in Price County, Wisconsin.

Price County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to accept any proposal they deem in the best interest of the Price County Highway Department.

Provided proposal forms may be submitted by mail or in person, by appointment only, in a sealed envelope marked "Base Aggregate Production 2023". All proposals must be submitted on the provided submittal form.

INSTRUCTION TO SUBMITTERS

Proposals will be received by the Price County Highway Department for crushing and stockpiling approximately 10,000 tons of ¾" crushed base aggregate dense gravel, 15,000 tons of 1 ¼" crushed base aggregate dense gravel and 600 tons crushed blacktop.

PIT LOCATION – Mintal Pit, Squaw Creek Road, Phillips, WI

MISCELLANEOUS FEES – The price given for crushing shall include all fees for production and stockpiling the crushed base aggregate dense gravel. Fees associated with stripping and cleanup shall be included in the price given. The County shall consider the proposal prices to be full payment for producing, stockpiling, and all incidentals associated with the base aggregate dense gravel.

ACCESS – Aggregate stockpiles must accommodate traffic in the pit.

GENERAL – The selection process will include consideration of price, adherence to specifications, warranty, references, and delivery time. Low quoted price will not be the limiting factor to award.

FORM OF PROPOSAL – The submitter must submit his/her proposal on the form furnished and here unto attached. All writing shall be done in ink.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SIGNING PROPOSAL – The full name and business address of each submitter must be entered in any and all proposals submitted. Each proposal shall be signed in the space provided therefore by written signature of the person or persons properly authorized to sign it.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL – The proposal shall be placed in an envelope or in separate envelopes, which shall be sealed. On the envelope or envelopes shall be plainly written "Base Aggregate Production 2023". Such envelopes shall be addressed and delivered to the Price County Highway Department, P.O. Box 169, 704 N. Lake Ave., Phillips, WI 54555 before the time specified in the official notice for opening proposals.

WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSALS – Any submitter may withdraw his proposal at any time prior to the scheduled time for the receipt of proposals provided the request is communicated to the Highway Commissioner before the time set for opening proposals. REJECTION OF PROPOSALS – The County Highway Department reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to accept any proposal deemed for the best interest of the Highway Department and waive any formalities or irregularities in proposals. Time is an essential consideration to providing the requested materials. Time will be a consideration in acceptance of the successful proposal.

TIME – All proposals must be submitted to the Highway Office by 12:00 p.m. on September 27, 2023.

PURCHASE PRICE – The purchase price shall include all work to be performed and all labor, materials, necessary tools, expendable equipment, freight, utility and transportation services, and incidentals necessary to crush and stockpile the materials.

PROPOSAL DEPOSIT – A bond or deposit in the amount of five percent must accompany each proposal. A proposal guarantee of five percent in certified funds (money order, certified check, etc.) made out to the Price County Treasurer shall accompany the contract. The proposal guarantee shall be returned upon successful delivery of the material. A performance and payment bond in the amount of 100 percent of the contract can be used in lieu of the proposal guarantee.
